## TRIP TO CADBURY WORLD



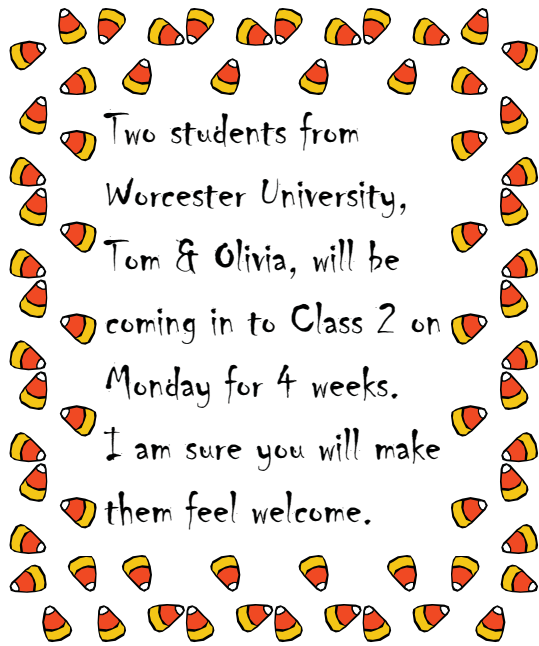
On Thursday the whole school went to Cadbury World for the day to find out all about chocolate.
